Category	Resolution Title	Resolution Description
Labor & Employment	15/Hour Minimum Wage	Guarantee a minimum wage of at least \$15/hour.
Natural Resources & the Environment	Protect Our Waters	water sources from pollution, commercialization, and export; upgrade our drinking water, wastewater, and stormwater infrastructure.
Civil Human & Constitutional Rights	Citizenship for Dreamers	Congress enact a law granting citizenship to all persons who came or were brought to the United States when under 16 years of age and who have continuously resided in the United States.
Civil Human & Constitutional Rights	Support of ERA	The Minnesota DFL will demonstrate its support for banning discrimination on the basis of gender by aggressively advocating for both 1) removal of the deadline for ratification of the federal Equal Rights Amendment and 2) passage of legislation to put an Equal Rights Amendment in the Minnesota State Constitution.
Civil Human & Constitutional Rights	LGBT Rights	Programs which aim to affect the sexual orientation or gender identity of individuals, also known as conversion therapy, should be made illegal in Minnesota. Minnesota will allow LGBT people to adopt children, and reject discrimination of all kinds in housing.
Health & Human Services	SNAP Funding	Resolve that Congress increase funding for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and promote local farmers and their efforts within the confines of that program
Energy	Clean Energy Policy	equitable clean energy transition and economy that creates high-paying jobs, encourages rural economic development and provides everyone with access to the benefits of clean energy. Do this in a way that reduces racial, gender and economic disparities and that meets or exceeds "net zero" emissions by 2050.

Public Safety & Crime Prevention	Red Flag Laws	<p>The Minnesota DFL supports commonsense gun violence prevention measures to keep guns out of the hands of people who have proven themselves to be dangerous, including background checks on all gun sales and extreme risk protection orders (often referred to as red flag laws). The Minnesota DFL further supports legislation to outlaw all semi-automatic and automatic guns for civilian use.</p>
Agriculture & Food	Reduce Pesticides	<p>Reduce or eliminate use of unsafe pesticides including glyphosate, neonicotinoids and chlorpyrifos.</p>
Energy	Clean Energy Transition Plan	<p>Support moving Minnesota beyond coal to clean energy by: transitioning to 100% carbon-free sources by 2050, requiring utilities to consider clean energy resources as replacement for retiring plants, increasing the energy efficiency goal for our major utilities from 1.5% to 1.75%, creating programs to encourage Minnesota families to use lower carbon (or zero carbon) technologies. Decarbonize, reduce waste, and increase energy efficiency across all sectors, promote a racially and economically just transition to clean energy, and promote practices that sequester carbon in the soil.</p>
Civil Human & Constitutional Rights	Water as a Human Right	<p>every human being has the right to safe, clean, affordable, and accessible water adequate for human consumption, cooking, sanitary purposes, agriculture, recreation, and tourism.</p>
Local or Party Issues	Rank Choice Voting	<p>The Minnesota State Presidential Primary be changed to Rank Choice Voting when there are four or more candidates on the same ballot.</p>
Veterans Affairs	End Veteran Homelessness	<p>Become the next state to end veteran homelessness.</p>
Civil Human & Constitutional Rights	Voting Rights for People with Felonies	<p>Minnesota shall support full voter enfranchisement and affirms that past criminal acts should have no bearing on voting eligibility in the future and urges the continuation of voting rights to those with criminal records, thus allowing all eligible citizens under Minnesota's constitution access to participate in our democracy.</p>

Media & Internet Issues	Border to Border Statewide Broadband Initiative	We call on the MN Legislature and Governor to support implementation and expansion of the Border to Border statewide Broadband initiative (1) by providing stable multi-year funding, (2) by eliminating corporate-monopoly sponsored restrictions, obstacles, and preemptions, (3) by encouraging municipalities and (4) by requiring all state-subsidized installers to go "the last mile," ensuring that every Minnesotan has access to today's and tomorrow's technology and that no one is left behind.
Civil Human & Constitutional Rights	Immigrant Bill of Rights	Immigrant Bill of Rights for all immigrants which shall include, but is not limited to, sanctuary status for the state of Minnesota, law enforcement and due process without regard to, or inquiry into, immigration status, driver's licenses under Freedom to Drive, full access to all public benefits for all residents of Minnesota such as childcare assistance funds and MinnesotaCare, affordable housing, paid family and medical leave, and earned sick time.
Local or Party Issues	Election Day Holiday	Declare national election days national holidays.
Health & Human Services	Abortion Access	Resolved that the DFL support affordable access to abortion while at the same time providing a breadth of options to provide support and resources needed to handle the challenges of pregnancy, adoption, and parenthood for those who choose to bear a child.
Natural Resources & the Environment	Lead-free Hunting and Fishing	Ban ammunition and fishing tackle containing lead or other toxic material.
Education	Equitable Public School Funding	Resolved that the Minnesota Legislature and Governor ensure that all public school students have access to local, high quality public education through an equitable funding formula.
Local or Party Issues	Popular Vote	The Minnesota Legislature should enact the National Popular Vote compact to guarantee the presidency to the candidate who receives the most popular votes in all 50 states and the District of Columbia.
