Public Safety & Crime Prevention	Background Checks on All Firearm Sales	Criminal background checks be required for all firearm sales in Minnesota.
Transportation Health & Human Services	Get the Lead Out	The DFL supports the reduction of lead exposure in people and animals by eliminating lead in drinking water, investing in lead remediation in Minnesota homes and other locations, and banning the use of lead ammunition and fishing tackle.
Civil, Human, & Constitutional Rights	Restore the Vote	Minnesota should pass legislation to allow people who have served their time and are living in their community to vote.
Transportation Health & Human Services	Clean Transportation	The DFL Party supports development of sustainable public transportation, including mass transit, commuter rail, light rail, and buses, charging stations for electric vehicles, as well as viable options for pedestrians, bicycles, and other non-motorized transportation options.
Natural Resources & the Environment	Prove It First	The DFL Party supports a moratorium banning copper-nickel sulfide mining in Minnesota's watersheds until it is proven first to be safe in water-rich environments. This will protect some of America's greatest treasures including but not limited to Lake Superior, the BWCAW, Voyageurs National Park, and the Mississippi River.
Agriculture, Food, & Land Stewardship	Reduce Pesticides	Reduce or eliminate the use of unsafe pesticides such as cancer causing glyphosate and neonicotinoids, which harm pollinators, in agriculture, recreational land, and lawns.
Transportation Health & Human Services	Make Insulin Affordable/Available	The DFL Party should support legislation to make insulin accessible and affordable for everyone who uses insulin and to ensure that an emergency source of insulin is available and affordable more than once a year.
Transportation Health & Human Services	Right to Abortion	The Minnesota DFL supports passage of the Protect Reproductive Options Act to secure the right to abortion.
Public Safety & Crime Prevention	Opposition to Stand Your Ground	We oppose "stand your ground" or "shoot first" laws which allow the use of deadly force anytime a person subjectively believes his or her life is threatened - even if there is a clear and safe way to avoid the danger.
Public Safety & Crime Prevention	Extreme Risk Protection	Law enforcement should be enabled to petition a court of law to temporarily prohibit people from possessing firearms if they pose a significant danger to themselves or others by possessing a firearm.

Civil, Human, & Constitutional Rights	Voting Rights	In response to the influx of restrictive voting legislation, this would make illegal all voting rules that discriminate on the basis of race, language, or ethnicity and empower voters to challenge discriminatory laws as detailed in the Freedom to Vote Act and the John Lewis Voting Rights Advancement Act.
Education	Higher Education Funding	Funding for higher education increase in order to reduce the costs for students. Also increase funding and other support for Community Colleges and Vocational Training.
Energy & Climate	Green New Deal	Support the federal Green New Deal goals of ending greenhouse gas emissions; establishing millions of high wage jobs and ensuring economic security for all; investing in sustainable and affordable housing and transportation for all; securing clean air and water, climate and community resiliency, healthy food, access to nature, and a sustainable environment for all; and promoting justice and equity with a ten-year mobilization effort.
Public Safety & Crime Prevention	Opposition to Permitless Carry	We oppose any efforts to weaken or eliminate our state's requirements for a permit to carry a handgun in public.
Civil, Human, & Constitutional Rights	Protect Voting Rights	Voting in elections is a right and responsibility of citizenship. We need to make the ability to vote easier to all people, particularly those for whom, historically have faced voter suppression. We must protect all voter rights.
Transportation Health & Human Services	Clean Water Infrastructure	The DFL supports upgrading our failing public water infrastructure: water treatment plants and the piping to supply public water, sewage and stormwater to assure safe drinking water and to protect aquatic ecosystems from pollution.
Civil, Human, & Constitutional Rights	Decriminalize and Expunge Cannabis	Support the decriminalization of all possession and use of marijuana for either medicinal or recreational purposes; the release from incarceration of all those currently serving prison time for such offenses; and the retroactive expungement of all criminal records related to these acts no longer considered to be criminal offenses.
Transportation Health & Human Services	Resolution for Abortion Protection	We call on state and federal officials to ensure that every Minnesotan should have access to safe, legal, affordable abortion services.
Civil, Human, & Constitutional Rights	Honor the Treaties	The state should honor the treaties with indigenous Minnesota tribes.
Civil, Human, & Constitutional Rights	Democracy - Voting Protections	Minnesota should pass a comprehensive proposal to ensure further protections for voters and elections officials against threat or intimidation.

Transportation Health & Human Services	End-of-Life Options Act	DFL supports passage of the End-of-Life Options Act, affirming that terminally ill, mentally capable adults should have the freedom to request, obtain, and self-administer medication for a peaceful death.
Transportation Health & Human Services	Single-payer Universal Health Care	Because health care is a human need, the Minnesota DFL Party supports the proposed Minnesota Health Plan (currently SF 1643/HF 1774), a comprehensive, affordable, universal health care system in which you keep your doctor and get the same or better care at lower cost because money is saved by cutting the administrative waste of multiple health insurance companies which have high billing and marketing costs and CEO salaries. Furthermore, the DFL Party supports enactment of the national Medicare for All of 2021 HR 1976.
Natural Resources & the Environment	Investing in Water Infrastructure	The DFL party supports increasing investments in the necessary infrastructure and implementing policies that protect water quality, remove lead service lines, and prioritize safe and affordable drinking water.
Transportation Health & Human Services	Bankruptcy due to Health Care	Minnesota DFL supports a health insurance system that prevents individuals and families from bankruptcy due to health costs.
Transportation Health & Human Services	Women's Reproductive Health	All women in Minnesota should have access to safe, legal abortion. All women should have access to reproductive health care throughout their lives including mammograms, pelvic exams, lactation consultation, and preventative doctor visits.
Agriculture, Food, & Land Stewardship	Sustainable Agriculture	The DFL supports funding for research, technical assistance and education to rapidly implement regenerative farming, establish perennial crops, rotational grazing, cover crops and no-till farming, to invest in rural communities and our food and farming system, conserve and build healthy soils, clean our water, sequester carbon and bolster farm income.
Racial, Ethnic, Gender, LGBTQ, & Economic Justice	Support Cannabis for Adult Use	The Minnesota DFL supports the legalization of cannabis for recreational, spiritual and medicinal use by responsible adults, regulating and taxing it in a manner similar to alcohol and tobacco, using the funds generated to support local schools, law enforcement, and community programs.
