

Rules and Information for Campaigns and Candidates

SD52 DFL Convention

Saturday, April 9, 2022

Registration begins at 9:00am - Call to Order at 10:00am**

- Campaigns may have access to the facility at 8:30 a.m. for set-up.
- Campaign sign policies:
 - No signs are allowed on the entrance doors to the school.
 - No signs may be posted on the grounds outside (including entrance doors) or on the roads leading to the building.
 - No more than six 2x3' signs (or equivalent signage not to exceed 36 square feet) may be posted at or in close proximity to a candidate's table.
 - No balloons allowed.
 - Each campaign is entitled to post an additional 36 square feet of signage in the convention hall in a location approved by the DFL52 Campaign Liaison. No campaign signs may be hung on or about the front of the room by the stage/speaking area.
 - Candidates shall be respectful of the limited space for displaying all the candidate signs. The Campaign Liaison shall have discretion to move or remove campaign signs.
 - Blue painter's tape must be used to hang the signs.
 - It is the responsibility of each campaign's volunteers to hang and remove the signs, as well as any other campaign materials. Materials left behind will be destroyed.
- Campaigns should make arrangements with the DFL52 Campaign Liaison for table space. Campaigns must bring their own table, and it must be no longer than 6 feet.
- Campaign literature or other materials may be handed out directly to individual delegates by a campaign representative but should otherwise be kept on a campaign's own campaign table. Campaigns may not place literature on chairs, tables, counters, etc. in the convention hall.
- Candidates and campaigns must check in at the credentials table upon arrival. Campaigns may have up to 5 floor passes for themselves and their campaign staff. If the candidate is a delegate in their own right, they have their own delegate floor pass, plus an additional 5 passes for staff.
- Candidates and campaign staff with credentials may circulate in the convention hall during the convention, except when the floor is frozen. Candidates or campaign staff that disrupt the convention may be asked to leave.
